## Gantry installation Pennant Hills Road, Beecroft / West Pennant Hills

We started work in October to install two gantries on Pennant Hills Road to monitor trucks and buses – in the north at Normanhurst and in the south at Beecroft / West Pennant Hills.

To complete this work, we need to close a section of Pennant Hills Road to safely lift and install the gantry.

### Closure of Pennant Hills Road

Pennant Hills Road will be closed between Aiken Road and Castle Hill Road on **Friday 3 January**, weather permitting.

The road will be closed for six hours from **11.59pm Friday 3 January to 6am Saturday 4 January**. Access onto Pennant Hills Road from local roads will also be restricted in this area. Resident and emergency services access will be maintained, during the gantry lift. There may be some delays where you need to wait up to 45 minutes to access your property. We will make every effort to get you to your destination as soon as we can and we thank you for your patience.

The detour of Pennant Hills Road may add up to 10 minutes travel time. Please plan your journey ahead where possible to ensure you reach your destination on time.

There will also be lane closures on the night before the closure, with variable message signs in place to advise motorists of the latest information on the closures.

We have provided a map to help explain the detour routes for light and medium vehicles during the closure.

If the gantry lift is postponed due to poor weather the work will be carried out on Sunday 5 January or Saturday 11 January. This will involve the same working hours, road closures and detours.

Day – 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday,  
8am to 1pm Saturdays

Night – 8pm to 5am Sunday to Friday

## How will the work affect you?

You will experience some noise and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > consulting with directly affected residents
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using noise blankets where possible
- > directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

## Ongoing work

Once the gantry has been installed we will need to connect the gantry to the Intelligent Transport System and restore the site. This work will take an additional eight shifts over a two month period. Our work will continue during our regular day and night work hours.

We will also need to return to carry out some utility relocation work.

## Plant and equipment

The project team will use an oversized delivery truck carrying the gantry, cranes, heavy and light vehicles, generators, lighting towers, power and hand tools.
