The NorthConnex project takes the health and wellbeing of the community and its workers very seriously.

The project team continues to follow a number of protocols to address the potential impact of COVID-19 while ensuring the continuation of its project delivery.

The measures are in-line with the latest advice issued by the Australian Government and NSW Health. Some of these measures include:

- Using email, mail, phone calls and video conferencing to communicate with residents and limiting door knocking where possible
- Maintaining a minimum 1.5 metre distance between workers and the community
- Not shaking hands
- Limiting external visitors to our sites
- Suspension of resident tunnel tours

The Community Information Centre located at 118 Yarrara Road, Pennant Hills, will open from Monday 7 September 2020. Opening hours are 9am - 1pm on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays or by appointment.
