## Gantry installation Pennant Hills Road, Beecroft / West Pennant Hills

We started work in October to install a gantry on Pennant Hills Road to monitor trucks and buses at Beecroft / West Pennant Hills.

To complete this work, a partial lane closure of a section of Pennant Hills Road is required to safely install a Variable Message Sign (VMS).

### Variable Message Sign installation

Two southbound lanes on Pennant Hills Road will be closed between Castle Hill Road and Aiken Road on the night of **Thursday 30 April**, weather permitting. Traffic control will be in place for the health and safety of our workers and motorists while this work is completed.

The lanes will be closed from **10pm on Thursday 30 April** and will reopen at **5am on Friday 1 May**. Access onto Pennant Hills Road from Hannah Street will also be restricted in this area. Resident and emergency services access will be maintained, during the work.

If work is delayed it will be done on the next available night shift. A map of the work area is provided.

### How will the work affect you?

You will experience some noise and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > consulting with directly affected residents
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using noise blankets where possible
- > directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

#### Work hours

Day – 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday,

8am to 1pm Saturdays

Night – 8pm to 5am Sunday to Friday

**Note that certain activities are now permitted to occur on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays without requirement to seek consent for Out of Hours Works.**

For the safety of motorists and workers, work may be carried out outside of these hours, in line with our environmental approvals.
