## Day and night work: Service installation and pedestrian diversion – Pearces Corner, Wahroonga

Dear resident,

Night work is continuing as part of ongoing work to widen Pennant Hills Road at Wahroonga. The work will include installing water, stormwater, electricity and communication services under Pennant Hills Road and pavement work, next to the Pearces Corner site compound. A map of the work area is provided in this notification.

Generally, this work will be carried out during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturday**, however for the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers, work will also be carried out at night between **9pm and 5am**.

It is expected the widening work will be complete by December 2018, weather permitting.

Plant and equipment includes a crane, light vehicles, lighting towers, vacuum truck, generators, excavators, jackhammers, trucks, rollers, concrete trucks, street sweeper, water cart, concrete saws, asphaltting and pavement machinery, and hand tools.

### Pedestrian footpath closure - continued

In order to carry out this work safely the pedestrian footpath on the northbound side of Pennant Hills Road will remain closed between Russell Avenue and Pacific Highway. Pedestrians are diverted to the footpath on the southbound side of Pennant Hills Road between Aaron Place and the Pacific Highway. Traffic management and signage is in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and workers. A map of the work area and pedestrian diversion routes is provided with this notification.

The main work activities include:

- > service investigation work
- > excavation and trenching
- > removal of a median on Pennant Hills Road
- > installation of services including water, stormwater, electricity and communication
- > asphaltting and pavement work.

### Managing impacts

You will experience noise during this work and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > consulting with directly affected residents
- > providing respite for residents most affected by noise

- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using solar-powered lighting towers.

### Traffic management

As part of this work, there will be night closures of two lanes in both directions on Pennant Hills Road between the Pacific Highway and Edwards Road. The closures will take place between **9pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday for up to three nights per week**, weather permitting. Traffic management and signage will be in place for the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
