Gantry installation Pennant Hills Road, Normanhurst

We started work in October to install two gantries on Pennant Hills Road to monitor trucks and buses – in the north at Normanhurst and in the south at Beecroft / West Pennant Hills.

To complete this work, we need to close a section of Pennant Hills Road to safely lift and install the gantry.

Closure of Pennant Hills Road

Pennant Hills Road will be closed between Dartford Road and Osborn Road on **Friday 13 December**, weather permitting.

The road will be closed for six hours from **11pm on Friday 13 December** and will reopen at **5am on Saturday 14 December**. Access onto Pennant Hills Road from local roads will also be restricted in this area. Resident and emergency services access will be maintained during the gantry lift. There may be some delays where you need to wait up to 45 minutes to access your property. We will make every effort to get you to your destination as soon as we can and we thank you for your patience.

The detour of Pennant Hills Road may add up to 10 minutes travel time. Please plan your journey ahead where possible to ensure you reach your destination on time.

We have provided a map to help explain the detour routes for light and medium vehicles during the closure.

If the gantry lift is postponed the work will be carried out on Saturday 14 December or Friday 10 January. This will involve the same working hours, road closures and detours.

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How will the work affect you?

You will experience some noise and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > consulting with directly affected residents
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using noise blankets where possible
- > directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

Ongoing work

Once the gantry has been installed we will need to connect the gantry to the Intelligent Transport System to restore the site. This work will take an additional eight shifts over a two month period. Our work will continue during our regular day and night hours.

We will also need to return to carry out some utility relocation work.

Plant and equipment

We will use an oversized delivery truck to carry the gantry, cranes, heavy and light vehicles, generators, lighting towers, power and hand tools.
