Gantry installation Pennant Hills Road, Beecroft / West Pennant Hills

We will start work to install a gantry on Pennant Hills Road as part of compliance regulations that will see trucks required to use the NorthConnex tunnel, unless they have a genuine destination accessed via Pennant Hills Road.

NorthConnex will return local streets to local communities and remove up to 5,000 trucks per day off Pennant Hills Road. The project will also help to reduce traffic noise on Pennant Hills Road for nearby residents.

Work will start on Monday 14 October, and will continue for about ten months, weather permitting.

The gantry will monitor trucks on Pennant Hills Road, and be located near the intersections of Hannah Street and Oratava Avenue. The work will involve utility relocation, relocation of a variable message sign, and installation of the gantry and signs. We have included a map of the work area over the page.

What will our work involve?

Work to install the gantry involves:

- 1. Setting up the site and removing some vegetation
- 2. Relocating underground utility services, trenching, drilling and installing services
- 3. Removing the existing Hannah Street electronic message sign, footpath and median on Oratava Avenue
- 4. Installing the footings for the gantry and electronic message sign, this includes excavation work and piling
- 5. Installing the gantry and electronic message sign
- 6. Connecting the gantry and electronic message sign to the Intelligent Transport System and restoring the site.

Most of our work will occur at Pennant Hills Road. Some work to relocate underground utilities and install the gantry footing will also be carried out on Hannah Street, Oratava Avenue, Aiken Road and Karloon Road.

Traffic management

How will the work affect you?

You will experience some noise and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- consulting with directly affected residents
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using noise blankets where possible
- > working no more than two nights in a row and no more than three nights in any week
- > directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, generators, excavators, jackhammers, grinders, concrete trucks, cranes, mulchers, street sweepers, water carts, vacuum trucks, and removal plant, power and hand tools.
